



**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
University of the Punjab
and
Institute of Orthopedics and Rehabilitation**


The University of the Punjab was established in 1882 and since then, have been approving curriculum, holding examinations and awarding degrees at undergraduate and postgraduate levels in affiliated medical and dental institutions in Punjab. In 2017, PU has decided to start its own education programs at the PU-Faculty of Health Sciences, arranged in seven (7) disciplines (medicine, dentistry, nursing, allied health sciences, public health, rehabilitation and physiotherapy & pharmacy), at four (4) PMDC levels (I- undergraduate, II- intermediate postgraduate, III- terminal postgraduate & IV- super specialization). To extend the PU academic and research standard, to other hospitals and centers, and to utilize their healthcare and research facilities for promotion of healthcare education, the University of the Punjab (known as **Party-1**) have decided to sign MoU with them.

“Institute of Orthopedics”-(IOR) located at 9- Usman Block New Garden Town Lahore; is a charity not for profit organization established by “Foundation of Healthcare improvement” (register with Security Exchange Commission of Pakistan). IOR have Center of “Physiotherapy” and Center of “Orthotics and Prosthetics” and provide health care services to the public at large, free of any charge, and offers its training facilities to the students of the University of the Punjab.

1. Both Party-1 and Party-2 are signing “Memorandum of Understanding” according to which, the Teaching & Training facilities of Party-2 shall stand affiliated with the Faculty of Health Sciences, University of the Punjab.
2. Both Party-1 and Party-2 shall start (self-supporting) joint teaching programs in various disciplines and at different levels and run them according to the standards&requirements of Higher Education Commission, Relevant Professional Councils and University of the Punjab.
3. For handling of the academic, administrative, quality, financial and student affairs aspects of the joint programs, a committee shall be constituted by both the parties (1 & 2), comprising of;
 - i. Dean, Faculty of the Health Sciences University of the Punjab. (Chairman)
 - ii. Managing Director of Institute of Orthopedics and Rehabilitation (Member)
 - iii. PU Head of the “Discipline” related to the Program. (Member)



4. The Party-2 shall pay a stipend to the candidates if the students provide services in the affiliated hospital.
5. The Party-2 shall maintain the academics and quality standards as laid down by the University of the Punjab.
6. All conflicts will be resolved in the light of the "Rules and Regulations" of the University of Punjab.


