



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

&

Institute of Chemical Engineering and Technology

University of the Punjab, Lahore

This document serves to seek academic collaboration between Department of Chemical Engineering, University of Gujrat (UOG) Pakistan (First Party) and Institute of Chemical Engineering & Technology, University of the Punjab (ICET, PU) (Second Party). Both universities offer degree programs ranging from BS (Honors) and MA/MSc/MPhil to Ph.D. in various disciplines.

Both parties agreed to establish the collaboration between Department of Chemical Engineering at University of Gujrat (UOG) and Institute of Chemical Engineering & Technology, University of the Punjab (ICET, PU). The University of Gujrat is one of the highest learning institutions of Pakistan established in recent years and is one of the fastest growing institutions of higher learning and research in the public sector of Pakistan. Department of Chemical Engineering provides quality education to undergraduate and graduate students with extensive theoretical and practical training that suits demands of chemical and process industries in Pakistan. Whereas, University of the Punjab is the oldest and largest University in the region. Institute of Chemical Engineering & Technology, University of the Punjab is the pioneer in chemical engineering education.

Both parties are agreed to collaborate in the following areas:

1. Joint research projects
2. Joint supervision of Master and PhD projects
3. Short-term faculty exchange (Visiting Professor) along with boarding and lodging
4. Students exchange for research and events along with boarding and lodging
5. Adjunct professor from ICET, PU to UOG and vice versa
6. Mutual sharing of Research equipment
7. Faculty visits under joint research projects/short-term faculty exchange will be considered as duty leave.
8. Any other point mutually agreed upon

This MOU shall not create any financial or legal obligations to either party, whatsoever, however a separate agreement may be signed with mutual consent depending upon the nature of the project.

This MOU shall be effective for five (5) years from the date of signature by the both parties. However, during execution, if any party realizes that the work is not likely to be completed within the specified timeframe, the matter will be mutually discussed to seek permission for required extension in the timeframe.
